THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PORT HOPE BY-LAW NO. XX-2024

Being a By-law to Authorize the Execution of an Agreement Between His Majesty the King in Right of Ontario as Represented by the Solicitor General ("Ontario") and the Corporation of the Municipality of Port Hope. ("The Municipality") for the Commissioner to assume policing responsibility for the rural area under Section 22(2)2 of the Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019 S.O.2019, c.1, Sched 1.

WHEREAS the Municipality of PORT HOPE deems it necessary to comply with the Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019 S.O.2019 (the Act); and

WHEREAS under the Act, the Municipality is required to ensure that policing shall be provided to ensure the safety and security of all persons and property; and

WHEREAS under Section 22(2)2 of the Act the Municipality may, with the Minister's approval, allow policing to be provided for in more than one way in different areas of the Municipality by entering into an agreement with the Minister to have the Commissioner assume policing responsibility for the area; and

WHEREAS Council, at its Meeting on November 26, 2024 considered Staff Report CAO-04-24;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of Port Hope enacts as follows:

- That the Mayor and Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Corporation, an Agreement with the Solicitor General for Police Services for the rural area of the Municipality of Port Hope with the terms and conditions as set out in Schedule "A".
- 2. That the Mayor and Municipal Clerk be and are hereby authorized and directed to sign the said Agreement and any related documentation to carry out the purpose of the By-law.
- 3. That this By-law shall come into force the day it is passed.
