Being a By-law to Repeal By-law 19/2014

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, Section 9 provides in part that a Municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority;

AND WHEREAS Council at the Committee of the Whole meeting held on May 3, 2022 considered Staff Report CS-08-22 regarding the adoption of a revised Public Notice Policy;

AND WHEREAS the Municipality of Port Hope is committed to ensuring that residents and stakeholders are informed of the business of the Corporation and the new Public Notice Policy outlines the circumstances in which notice shall be given and provides communications methods that are more relevant to today's technology and means of communicating with the community;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Port Hope hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That By-law 19/2014 being a By-law to Adopt a Public Notice Policy is hereby repealed in its entirety.
- 2. THAT this By-law shall come into force the day it is finally passed.
