THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PORT HOPE BY-LAW NUMBER 60/2021

Being a By-law to Appoint a Municipal By-Law Enforcement Officer

WHEREAS the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter p.15, Section 15 provides in part that a Municipal Council may appoint persons to enforce the Bylaws of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS Section 15 (2) of the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, defines municipal law enforcement officers as peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws;

AND WHEREAS the Provincial Offences Act R.S.O 1990, c. P 33 provides for the designation by a Minister of the Crown of any person or class of persons as a Provincial Offences Officer for the purposes of all or any class of offence;

AND WHEREAS Samantha Taylor was appointed by the Municipality to perform the duties of Municipal Law Enforcement Officer effective September 27, 2021 and this By-law serves to formally appoint Samantha Taylor in accordance with legislative requirements;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Port Hope enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT Samantha Taylor is hereby appointed as Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer who shall act as Peace Officer for the purpose of enforcing the municipal By-laws under the Provincial Offences Act.
- 2. THAT this By-law shall take force and effect the day it is passed.

READ a first, second and third time and finally passed in Open Council this 19th day of October, 2021.
