## THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PORT HOPE

## BY-LAW NO. 61/2023

## Being a By-law to Confirm the Proceedings of the Council Meeting of the Corporation of the Municipality of Port Hope at its Council Meeting Held on November 7, 2023

WHEREAS Section 5(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, provides that the powers of a Municipality shall be exercised by its Council;

AND WHEREAS Section 5(3) of the Municipal Act, 2001, as amended, provides Municipal power, including the Municipality's capacity, rights, powers and privileges under Section 8, shall be exercised by by-law, unless the Municipality is specifically authorized to do otherwise;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Port Hope enacts as follows:

- THAT Subject to Section 3 of this by-law, every action and decision of the Council taken at the meeting at which this by-law is passed, and every resolution passed at that meeting, shall have the same force and effect as if each and every one of them had been the subject matter of a separate by-law duly enacted;
- 2. THAT the execution and delivery of all such documents as are required to give effect to the decisions taken at the meeting at which this by-law is passed and resolutions passed at this meeting, are hereby authorized;
- 3. THAT nothing in this by-law has the effect of giving to any decision or resolution the status of a by-law where any legal prerequisite to the enactment of a specific by-law has not been satisfied;
- 4. THAT the Chief Administrative Officer and the appropriate Director of the Corporation are hereby authorized and directed to do all things necessary to give effect to the said actions of Council referred to them at the meeting at which this by-law is passed;
- 5. THAT any member of Council who disclosed a pecuniary interest at the meeting at which this by-law is passed, shall be deemed to have disclosed that interest in this confirmatory by-law as it relates to the item in which the pecuniary interest was disclosed.

READ a FIRST, SECOND and THIRD time and finally passed in Open Council this 7<sup>th</sup> day of November, 2023.
